Logan River Restoration



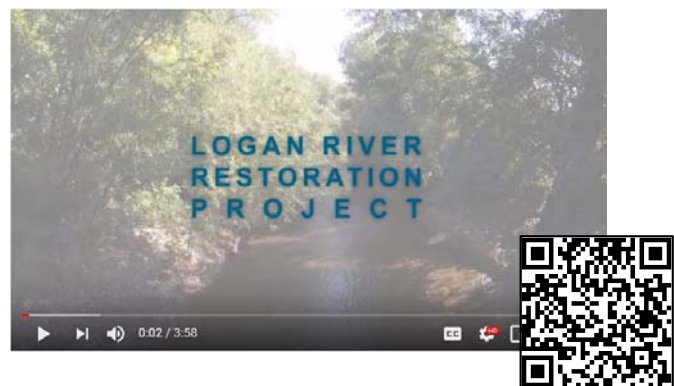
Efforts are continuing to improve flood conveyance, ecological conditions, and public access and enjoyment of the Logan River.

- Projects began in 2015 with grants from the Utah Division of Water Quality and matching funds from Logan City.
- The Logan River Task Force developed a Conservation Action Plan (CAP) to guide projects. The CAP includes 22 indicators of Logan River health. The vision of the CAP is to:

“Make the Logan River system a showcase of ecologically viable, socially beneficial river restoration.”
